


Coronavirus Too many deaths



The **First Wave** of coronavirus started in February and ended in June 2020.

A report by Public Health England says **1000 people** with a learning disability died from **Covid-19**.

What the report says – a summary

People with a learning disability were six times more likely to die than other people.



Sometimes a learning disability was used as reason not to **resuscitate** someone.





Those aged 18 to 34 were thirty times more likely to die. Extra health problems like diabetes or breathing difficulties made some people more at risk.

Sometimes carers didn't spot when someone was getting really ill.
